Description

An impressive oak drumhead mantel clock dating to the mid 19th century. The drum contains a bevel edge glass over a two piece enamel dial that has a jewelled brocot visible escapement. The base has a glazed front panel flanked by canted corners with carved decoration. The 8 day bell striking movement as a gridiron pendulum and was made by Marti of Paris
