Description

A very original English mahogany bracket clock. It has a break arch top case, with a heavy brass carrying handle, an arch door with a brass inset sight frame. It has Gothic tracery brass side frets, and adjustable brass ball feet. The white painted enamel dial is sign by the maker William Collier of London, and has a strike/silent feature within the arch, . It has a twin fusee movement that strikes the hours on a bell, with a calibrated Thwaites style pendulum.. It also has an hour repeater cord.
