Description

A fine and very original, George III mahogany London made bracket clock. It has a break arch top case with a brass carrying handle, inset brass sight ring, brass ogee bracket feet and brass fishscale fret sides. The finely engraved silvered dial is signed by the maker George Younge, Strand, London.

The twin fusee movement strikes the hours on bell and has an engraved backplate with a pendulum holdfast for transportation.

George Younge is listed as a fine maker 1776-1815 and has a watch in The Greenwich museum.
