Description

A small, mahogany granddaughter clock, in the late 18th Century style. It has a break arch top with reeded side pillars and side frets, and a long door. The brass dial has a thick bevel edge front glass. It has an 8 day Westminster chiming movement that sounds the quarters and hours on rods. It has a long pendulum with a brass cylinder bob, below there is a maker's stamp of Kienzle of Wurtemberg. There is a facility to silence the chime.
